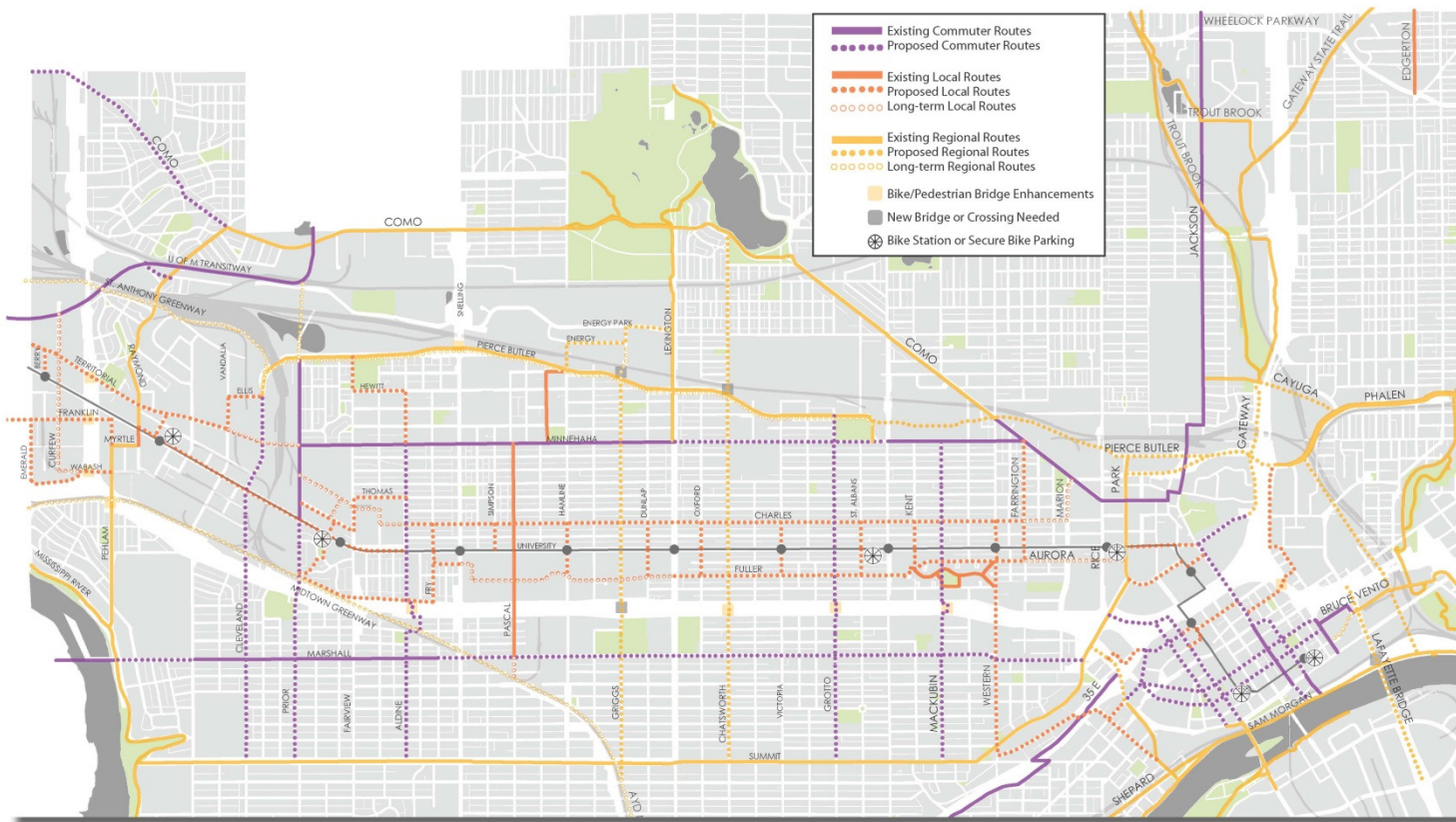


Marshall Avenue Complete Street Mississippi River to John Ireland

- ❑ Snelling to John Ireland (2013)
 - ❑ TLC Funded Design Community Process led by Toole Design Group (\$50,000)
 - ❑ Initial Concepts to be Vetted
 - Concordia College, Dunning Field, Central High Bike, Ped and Safety Improvements
 - Improvements at Traffic Signals
 - Bike Lanes – Snelling to Victoria
 - Bike Boulevard – Victoria to Western
 - Contraflow Bike Lanes – Western to John Ireland

- ❑ Mississippi River Blvd to Fry Section (2014)
 - Bike Lanes and some Medians completed under past projects
 - Construct Median at Merriam Park Library
 - Improvements at Prior – St. Marks School
 - Cleveland Business District
 - Macalester High Winds Fund has committed \$50,000 Matching Funds
 - ❑ Snelling to Lexington (2015)
 - ❑ Lexington to John Ireland (2016)
